Casey Trout

- Minutes reviewed and approved from January Meeting

New Business

- Sam and Susie Smargissi
 - 7v7 football tournament being held at BHS June 2, 2023
 - Discussed options with Boosters for having the concession stand open during the tournament hours of 5-10 pm. Half to each football and booster or 100% going to football.
 - Sam and Susie will discuss options with Coach Harris and bring back their request at the next meeting.
- Coach Webster (Indoor Track)
 - Both boys and girls won indoor track county championships
 - Submitted invoice for \$1,879.37 for 134 t shirts to commemorate season
 - Aubrey made a motion to fund up to \$1,900.00. Charity 2nd motion

Treasurer's Report – Aubrey Wanner

- Aubrey had some indoor track meet fees that were set aside for but hadn't seen any invoices. Kevin Necessary was going to look into situation and send invoice to Boosters for payment.
- Baseball field work – Aubrey requested final invoice to be sent to her as well so payment can be made to contractor.
- Joan Miller will be taking over Treasurer's position for Aubrey when she decides to leave.

Membership – Lisa Cain

- Winter sports numbers
 - Indoor track 129 roster 94 members 73%
 - Swimming 45 roster 33 members 73%
 - Girls BBall 26 roster 18 members 69%
 - Boys BBall 30 roster 19 members 63%
 - Wrestling 49 roster 30 members 61%
 - Cheer 37 roster 18 members 49%
 - Bowling 64 roster 28 members 44%
 - Total 380 roster 240 members 63%
- Spring sport numbers from Kevin Necessary
 - 55 new members of 234 registrations

- Approximately 50% are already signed up from previous sport seasons

Concessions – Charity Isaac

- Spring schedule being put together and will be posted for sign up genius
- As of now, 10 total events in the spring will need staffing
- 1 slot in concessions open for event on 2/15
- Concession stand will be open from 7:30 am to 2:00 pm for wrestling tournament on 2/18
- Charity still needs replacement or several people to help with concessions going into next year.
- Charity suggested rotation of 3 people to team up and run stand during busiest fall season.
- Kathi Burroughs has volunteered to be a shopper next year for the concession committee.

Merchandise – Trish Shroll (not present)

Social Media/Communications – Sara Gibb

- Mulch sale posts created and being pushed on media sites
- Suggested to print flyers out and post them in local businesses to help sales as well. Lisa Cain will create QR code for volunteer possibilities as well

Mulch Sale – Bob Boyer

- Date confirmed as March 25, 2023
- Kevin suggested shorter shifts for teams so coaches can be more accountable for what their athletes are doing. Kevin will create schedule and send for suggestions.
- Capping total at 4,500 bags to be purchased. Booster bag cost is \$3.48 per bag with a \$66 delivery fee per truck load.
- Christy confirmed pick up option is OK with her during the hours of 9-12pm. Anyone picking up will be given a smaller window to come to help mitigate traffic.
- Signs to be put out starting this weekend.
- Sign up genius created for volunteering on day of (drivers, traffic, water/food donations)

Golf Tournament

- Confirmed for June 19, 2023
- Still no confirmed chairperson
- Casey was going to speak with Dawn Orso regarding helping. Casey also mentioned he had a few other people in mind that can help out with tournament.

Kevin Necessary

- Recognized successes throughout the entire athletic program from the fall and into the winter.
 - Girls and Boys Indoor track, Boys and Girls Swimming all won county championships this winter.
 - Girls and Boys basketball currently in playoffs. Possible home games coming up. Boys could have 3 home games and girls have 1. Concession opportunities.
 - Wrestling tournament 2/18 and 2/19
 - Kevin was going to send an email to Aubrey for posting on the booster website with all of the successes so far with the athletic teams.
 - Bermuda Field update
 - Irrigation systems on both Bermuda fields need to be completely replaced.
 - Contractor that AACPS deals with said cost to replace will be \$84,300.00.
 - Kevin was not sure of how project would be funded. Will keep us posted on any updates.
 - Kevin recommended BHS Boosters earmark half of total amount as a potential cost to replace the irrigation system, \$42,150.00. Aubrey made motion and Casey seconded earmark of \$42,150.00 in budget to help with irrigation system repair.
 - Potential of \$65,000 more in total work for field renovation work quoted earlier.
