Meeting called to order at 6:02 PM

### **President - Charity Isaac**

- Minutes approved from September Meeting
- Charity welcomed any new parents to the meeting and asked for them to introduce themselves in the Zoom chat with name and what sport their student athlete plays

### **Treasurer's Report - Aubrey Wanner**

- Shared budget on Zoom
- Has a \$30,000 concession deposit to make
- Numbers currently include through end of September, including PayPal deposits
- Just paid for fall sport senior banners
- Approximately \$40,000 to pay off weight room - Concession money will help with that!
- Netting \$10,000 a week for concessions

### **Membership - Lisa Cain/Karen Morseberger - not present**

- Lisa Cain emailed the current membership numbers:
- Golf - 94%                                      Football - 68%
- Boys Soccer - 79%                              Girls Soccer - 64%
- Volleyball - 74%                                \*Fall Cheer - 59% (Coach Richardson joined to try to get to 60%)
- Field Hockey - 68%                              Unified Tennis - 27%
- Cross Country - 65%

\*Coach Necessary would like to purchase new uniforms for cheer. Board was adamantly against this. We need the team to meet the 60% goal as outlined by Boosters in order for Boosters to help pay for them. Aubrey Wanner to draft a letter and send it to Coach Necessary. He will forward it to Coach Richardson to send to all team parents so they know if they have a few more members, their uniforms will be paid for.

- Winter Meet the Coaches Night will be December 1st. Lisa and Karen will work on packets as in the past to hand out. Aubrey and Charity also working on a video to present to new parents.

### **Craft Bazaar - Beth Capps**

All craft bazaars in the county have been cancelled. Nate Johnson is still waiting on an answer from the administration. Glen Burnie has the 2nd largest (only to ours) and has the same amount of vendors but ½ the attendance we do and their proposal was shot down. Does not look good for us. Chesapeake, N. County and Southern have also cancelled.

- We discussed a spring bazaar - but too hard to manage between Mulch and Golf Tournament
- Parking could be an issue with spring sports - no open Saturdays in the spring
- Vote taken and the bazaar has been officially cancelled!
  - Beth and Aubrey to handle refund checks and will have some that will want to roll-over deposit in order to secure their space for next year

### **Concessions - Jenna Ray**

- Playoff schedule is out and lots of openings on sign-up genius
- Charity asked any liaisons to forward sign-up genius link
- Desperately need 2-3 people to take over concessions - Sophia will not be able to help in the spring
  - WE ARE AT RISK OF NOT HAVING CONCESSIONS IN THE SPRING
- Coach Necessary to put sign on the inside concession door that there will not be concessions for winter sports due to covid/masking
- If football wins on Friday, there will not be a playoff on the 5th, but changed to the 12th

### **Merchandise - Tricia Schroll**

- Tricia will be available to set up for Meet the Coaches night on Dec. 1, may need someone to help roll the carts outside
- Will get with Charity to order more Pure Vida bracelets - big seller
- Jen Peacock asked if Tricia could have a "Unified Sports" sign

### **Social Media/Communications**

- Still looking for a replacement - Aubrey also handling Treasurer position
- Person needs to have good knowledge and can update Facebook, Instagram, Constant Contact

### **Mulch Sale**

- Keith Meisner will help with mapping, but still need a lead to replace John Bragaw

### **Golf Tournament**

- Tentative date of Wednesday, June 22 as that is the last day for Teachers
- To be held at Bay Hills again

### **Athletic Director Report - Kevin Necessary**

- Scoreboard delayed for Turf 2
- Issue with on-site trainer discussed:
  - BHS does not have a trainer
  - ATI and industry in general has a shortage of trainers
  - Football games must have a trainer according to MD Law
  - Severna Park and BHS only 2 schools without a trainer
  - Coach Necessary working with ATI and will have a trainer for both soccer games on Friday and one on Monday for field hockey

- This is in no way a breach of the contract we have with ATI
  - Whole trainer on site has only been around for about 7 years
- Will alert coaches to discuss with athletes/parents
- We have a 3 year contract with ATI and Kevin is on the committee
- Clarification of testing for winter sports:
  - Weekly testing for those not vaccinated
  - Proof of vaccination has not been rectified yet
- One last note, Coach Necessary thanked everyone on the call for helping with all sport related Booster items that have lifted the spirits of all student athletes this fall - kids are doing great, 2 soccer county championships, golfer in state championship etc. Huge lift this fall!
